# FACILITIES

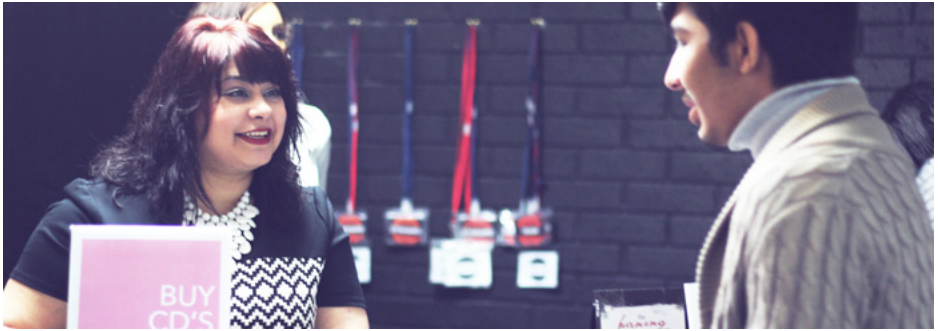

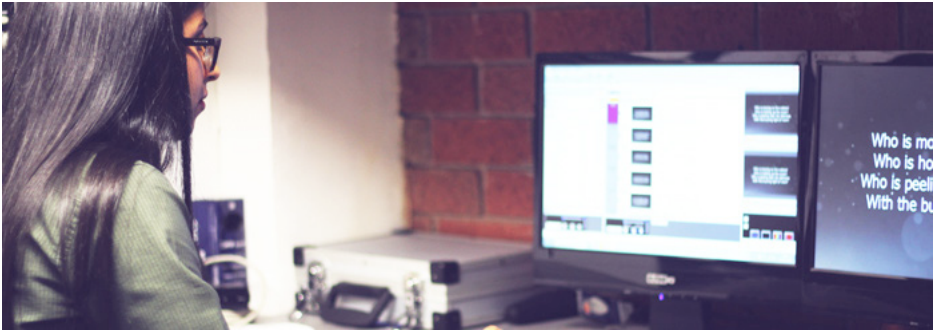
