



Summary of Sermon

Ps Esther spoke on Serving: Kingdom Compassion from Matt 25:31-46.

“Showing love does not depend on how much we have but on how we share what we have.”

“It is not just what we say to people but how we *live* that makes a difference.”

“God does not want you unsettled ... He wants you heartbroken over what breaks His heart.”

Questions

1. Why does God insist that we should love broken and marginalised people?
2. The sheep and goats (Matthew 25) are separated on the basis of whether they serve Jesus by loving others or not - why does serving the poor mean we are serving Jesus?
3. Esther encouraged us to show love to marginalised people who are different from ourselves. What kinds of things make it hard for us to do this? How can we love people we find difficult?
4. As a Life Group, pray together to ask God to show the needs around you in the immediate neighbourhood or the parts of the community your Life Group touches. Ask Him to show you how He sees these people. Ask for wisdom to know how to love and also to keep yourselves and others safe.
