Growing in the favour of God

God's favour is far more effective than our own labour, but whilst we get blessed in the process, it is important that it comes through us to bless others than it is for us to keep hold of.

God is good but expect His past goodness to you to be exceeded in this present year of favour.

To grow in receiving God's favour:

- Make the Lord your highest delight.
- Show God's love to the least, the lost and the last.

Key scriptures: Isaiah 54:1-5 and 61:1-7, Habakkuk 1:5

1. Pray for your local community and ask God how we can intentionally engage more with the lost, the least, the last and the lonely.
2. Look at Psalm 103
Can you "pray" this scripture – making it personal to yourself/yourselves and declare these things over you.
3. What is it about the gospel and being saved that really delights you?
What was your first delight on being saved?
It need not be complicated but helps you recall God's blessing and see how someone else's life could be transformed by knowing Jesus.
