



## Summary of Sermon

Pastor Steve read all of John 16 and highlighted the following:

- Jesus forewarns us of trouble and persecution from the world for following him.
- He hasn't left us alone and has sent a friend to accompany us: the Holy Spirit.
- Jesus tells us to ask of Father God, in his name, and receive with joy.

## Questions

1. The world judged wrongly in not recognising Jesus as Christ, saviour, son of God.  
Why should we not judge by the world's own standards?
2. How differently is God telling us to act, be, decide, acquire, compared to the world's ways?  
Why is God trying to get us to shift our behaviour so much?
3. It sounds like there was a legal court battle going on, with judgements, an accuser, an advocate/attorney/assistant/helper/guide, a verdict and victory.  
How were we judged, by whom and why?  
Who lost?  
Who won?  
Is the case still going on or has it been decided?
