Making It Rain

Manuel shared about generosity being our identity in God. It is about how God, loving humanity and the world, gave himself in Christ and about our love for God and all that is His.

For God, generosity is much more than us just giving money (the “when” and “what”) but about our heart and desires (the “why” and “how”).

We are encouraged to decide to be generous, to at least begin by believing and trusting God with small, regular, planned acts, and from there to grow in a relationship of generosity with Him.
