In Ezekiel 37.3 God asked Ezekiel about the dry bones living.

Part of being in the kingdom is about acting on what God says rather than reacting to what we otherwise see, hear or feel.

Wherever you are, you have seeds to sow, water and cultivate God's garden.

3 You were never created to live a life that you could live without God's help.

Challenge and difficulties are part of forming you into Christ's image.
