



Summary of Sermon

Ps Rick spoke on sacrifice, not just singing songs saying “I will do anything for You, Lord” but living sacrificially in our daily lives.

Matt 14:22-36 - Peter risked everything to walk on water.

Mark 14:3-9 - the kind of sacrifice God looks for.

Malachi 1:6-12 - the kind of sacrifice God does not want.

Sacrifice means giving and loving. Sacrifice is of eternal worth.

Questions



First, how have we all been able to BLESS this week?

1. What kept the other disciples from joining Peter walking on the water?
2. “If it is easy ... it isn’t sacrifice.” Why doesn’t God make it easy for us?
3. Ps Rick passionately urged us to sacrifice a little time and convenience to join in praying in the Prayer Hub, to cry out to God for the city and the world. In October there will be two new, additional nights. Can your Life Group plan between you to be in the Prayer Hub for 2, 4 or more (!) hours on a regular basis?
