## Questions

1. How can sinners in darkness be expected to stand and even walk in the light of him whose "eyes were like blazing fire" and whose "face was like the sun shining in all its brilliance" (Revelation 1.12-17)?
2. Can you think of examples in the bible of people being judgmental and so hindering the guilty and ashamed from coming to God?
3. What did Jesus mean in Matthew 6.23?
4. In John 3.20-21 doing evil is associated with hiding in darkness from the light, and that is contrasted with doing truth and coming into the light. How should we let the world see God's light in their lives though? Should we be proud and showy about God's favor to us?
